The Wayne Hyde 4-H Memorial project has a balance of \$2,250 after paying for the excavation and grass seed. The cement work, roof changes, the addition to the pistol range, electrical updates and other miscellaneous repairs and supplies is estimated to cost \$10,000 more. Gary made a motion to commit an additional \$8,500 to this project, Ken supported and the motion carried.
